**PARKING**

Students may park in the student parking lot or on the streets around school where parking is legal. Illegally parked cars will be cited by the LAPD or towed. Students' cars parked in the faculty parking lot WILL BE CITED AND MAY BE TOWED.

**DROPPING OFF OR PICKING UP STUDENTS**

For safety reasons, parents are not to drop off or pick up students in the faculty parking lot. Posted student drop-off zones are on the corners of Valley Circle Blvd/Burbank Blvd. and Valley Circle Blvd/Mariano St.

**WORK EXPERIENCE**

Enrollment packets will be available on the first day of school in the Counseling Office. Students may enroll during brunch, lunch, or during their Work Experience periods. Completed packets must be returned by the deadline date for students to be considered enrolled in Work Experience. Students enrolled in Work Experience are entitled to leave school after lunch.

**TEMPORARY LUNCH PASSES**

Lunch passes will be issued to 12<sup>th</sup> grade students on Monday, August 24th and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students on Tuesday, August 25th, in the Deans' Office between 8:00 - 10:30 am. In order to apply for a lunch pass, a student must have fewer than ten absences in any class on the fall and spring 10<sup>th</sup>/11<sup>th</sup> grade final report cards. Two tardies count as one absence. Absences for approved school activities are not counted. (continued)  
\*New lunch pass applicants must bring a notarized application or be accompanied by a parent. Blank applications for notarization may be

picked up in advance in the Deans' Office the week of August 17th. The issuance of a lunch pass is a privilege, not a right.

**Permanent** lunch passes will be issued after I.D. pictures are taken in September.

A student may appeal two or more consecutive days absence due to doctor verified illness or injury, or two or more consecutive days of family emergency verified by parent/guardian. To begin the appeal procedure, the student must contact his/her Dean within three days of returning to school.

***\*Textbook delinquencies must be met before applying for a lunch pass.***

Students who do not qualify for a lunch pass at the beginning of the 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade year, may apply in the spring, based on their final fall semester report card. New and transferring students must meet ECR requirements in order to obtain a lunch pass.

#### **ECR HAT POLICY**

Parents, faculty, and the Student Council have voted on an "ECR only" hat policy. **No other hats will be allowed on campus.** Confiscated hats may be picked up from the Deans' Office after 3:30pm. Continual defiance of this rule could lead to further disciplinary action.

#### **ECR CELL PHONE/MP3/I-POD POLICY**

Any electronic devices, I-Pods, MP3 or CD players, and/or cellular phones that cause a disturbance on campus or in a classroom will be confiscated. If confiscated, items may be picked up from the Deans' Office after 3:30pm. **All cell phones are to remain off and not be visible during school hours, including during Nutrition and Lunch. Continual defiance of this rule could lead to further disciplinary action.**

#### **EARLY LEAVES**

Students who need to be excused early from school for any reason must bring a note to the Counseling Office **before** school. The note must include a phone number where the parent can be reached before 10:00 am. Parent verification by phone is required before the student is permitted to leave. In instances where parents know they cannot be reached, the parent should call the school to verify the note. Under no circumstances may a student leave campus without a contact between parent and school, or a truancy will result.

#### **STUDENT DEBTS**

In these times of increasing prices for printed material, lost and damaged textbooks cannot be treated lightly. The average cost of a new book is \$80. If every student misplaces only one textbook each semester, ECR would lose nearly \$300,000. We know that parents want to protect their taxpayers' investment in education by encouraging their children to properly care for all books and school property.

#### **ATTENDANCE**

Students are expected to be in class on time, ready to work, every period of every day. Period 0 begins at **7:00am**; Period 1 begins at **8:01am**. All absences must be cleared through the Counseling Offices or students will be marked as truant.

#### **TRUANCY**

It is unlawful for students under the age of 18 to wander or loiter on school days from 8:30 am to 1:30 pm. Students found loitering could be issued a truancy ticket by LAPD, charged a fine, and ordered to appear in Juvenile Traffic Court with a parent or guardian.

#### **COMPLAINTS ABOUT EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM**

The California Department of Education requires schools to notify the public of procedures for handling complaints about educational programs conducted with state or federal funds. Any person, organization, or public agency concerned about a violation of state or federal regulations governing an educational program is to submit a written complaint to the Associate Superintendent, Specially Funded Programs, 333 S. Beaudry Ave., Los Angeles, CA 90012. The complaint must be filed within six months of the alleged violation.

Within five days of receipt, the designated office will determine if the complaint has been filed in a timely manner, provide the complainant with a copy of district policy and appeal procedures, ensure confidentiality of the complaint, and determine whether the complaint will be resolved by mediation prior to a formal investigation. Each complaint shall be investigated by the appropriate District Office within sixty days of the receipt of the written complaint. Any complainant(s) may appeal the

District's decision by filing a written appeal with the State Superintendent within fifteen days after receiving the district decision.

If further information is needed, contact Mr. Dean Bennett, Assistant Principal. This information is also available in Spanish, Armenian, Chinese, and Korean.

#### **COFFEE WITH THE PRINCIPAL**

Parents are invited to attend a one hour coffee with our Principal and/or Assistant Principal, on various Fridays throughout the year, at 8:15 am in the Principal's Conference Room. General discussions will cover current issues, concerns, school policies and procedures, etc. depending on the administrator present at the meeting. This is not the forum to discuss issues specific to your student. Please RSVP to the Main Office @ 595-7503 if you plan to attend.

#### **PTSA**

PARENTS, TEACHERS, AND STUDENTS ASSOCIATION (PTSA) is a parent, teacher and student organization dedicated to augmenting and enriching the students' education at El Camino Real High School. In **November 2007**, the **Los Angeles Unified School District** began the implementation of a District-wide notification system called **Connect-ED** which enables us to personally communicate with parents/guardians, and staff, regarding emergency situations, attendance, school events and other important issues impacting you and your child.

The **Connect-ED** service allows us to send personalized voice messages to your family's home, work or cell phones, and also contact you through email. We are capable of reaching everyone in our school within minutes through the **Connect-ED service**. This improves school and District communications with our parents/guardians and employees. Keeping parents/guardians more informed and involved has shown to lead to higher student achievement.

Please help us by ensuring we have your current contact information. For the first time, the District has the ability to customize where you receive general notification, attendance and emergency communications.

### **What Numbers Should I provide for Connect-ED?**

There are three times when the school will attempt to reach you.

- **General** notification messages are sent during the early evening. These messages are non-emergency in nature and announce upcoming events or reminders.
- **Attendance** notification messages are sent during the school day and into the early evening. The most appropriate number is a daytime telephone number. If you are a working parent/guardian, this is most often your work number or cell phone number. If the parent/guardian is home during the day, this is the home telephone number. It is recommended that the attendance number not be the home number if no one is there during the day.
- **Emergency** notification messages are of an urgent nature and can be sent anytime. The number you should provide is where you are most likely to be reached. **Connect-ED** will call every number stored including the numbers for general and attendance notifications to ensure that the parents/guardians are reached. This number should be for the parent/guardian and not the alternate contacts provided on the emergency cards. The information on the emergency cards will be utilized should the school not be able to reach the parent/guardian.

Indicate on the attached form which numbers you would like us to use for the different types of messages. Please be aware that the **Connect-ED** service cannot dial an extension, so be sure the numbers you include are direct lines.

### **Important Call Delivery Tips:**

1. When a call comes from the school (or District), the message recipient's caller ID will display the school (or District's) name and phone number.
2. When listening to a message, background noise may cause the system to "stop and start". **Connect-ED** is carefully tuned to determine whether a person or an answering machine/voicemail has been reached, and background noise may affect the delivery of the message. If possible, move to a quiet area, or press the "mute" button on your phone.
1. If you missed any part of a message, please stay on the line and press the "\*" (star) key on your phone to hear the entire message again.

Please have your child return the attached completed form *as soon as possible*.

I plan to use the **Connect-ED** service to send school-wide messages throughout the year. It is important that the school has your current contact information so you can receive these important messages. Please be assured that all personal information will be maintained in the strictest confidence and in compliance with District security policies.

Dear El Camino Real Students and Parents:

RE: ECR ACTIVITY CARD - \$30

The Conquistador Activity Card is back and with it comes phenomenal savings for the student and increased support for all ECR activities. At present all other Northwest Valley Conference schools have, or are planning to have, an Activity Card.

Activity Card holders have free access to all practice and league football games and to home basketball games. Without an Activity Card, half the money goes to the opponent's school. With an Activity Card, all money remains at ECR. In addition, all cardholders receive a reduced price for dances, musical and stage productions, and \$5 off the cost of the yearbook.

All students enrolled in athletic teams, auxiliary groups, journalism, yearbook, drama, music, and student council are expected to purchase an Activity Card, as this money helps to fund these activities. Everyone else can support the extracurricular program and save money at the same time. Check out the savings:

SUBJECT: SENIOR ATTENDANCE/TARDY POLICY

## 1. Objectives

- a. To improve attendance, punctuality, and student achievement.
- b. To heighten awareness of the importance of good attendance and punctuality.
- c. To reduce truancy.
- d. To curb "senioritis" (excessive absences/tardies by seniors).

## 2. Policy

During any semester, seniors who exceed ten absences or ten tardies in **any period** will be denied the privilege of participation in the senior prom (based on the fall semester attendance and tardies) and/or the graduation ceremony (based on the spring semester attendance and tardies).

- a. Authorized school activities are not included.
- b. Students may submit two notes per semester, signed by a parent, to their Period 0 or Period 1 teacher excusing tardies to Period 0 or Period 1 **only**.
- c. New and transferring students must meet El Camino Real attendance/tardy requirements in order to participate in the senior prom or graduation ceremony.

## 3. Appeal process

Students appealing their denial of the graduation ceremony and/or senior prom need to complete the required school forms and return them completed and signed with the required documentation to their Dean. Acceptable absences for appeal are:

- a. Medical - two or more days of continuous absence verified by a doctor's note.
- b. Death in immediate family.
- c. Regularly scheduled medical appointments - verified by doctor's note, including time and date of each appointment. Explain why this has to be done during school hours.
- d. Special circumstances - attach statement explaining circumstances and necessary documentation.
  - All documentation for medical, death in immediate family, and medical appointments must be original notes brought to the Counseling Office when returning from absence. The Appeals Committee will gather this documentation.
  - Truancies are not appealable under any circumstances.
  - Forgeries of any document may result in loss of appeal process.
  - Period 0 or Period 1 tardies in excess of 10 may be worked off, **THROUGH THE DEANS OFFICE ONLY**, during the first five weeks of the Spring semester (for Fall) and during the final three weeks of the school year (for Spring semester)

## 4. Appeals Committee

The Appeals Committee will be composed of one teacher, one administrator, one parent, one student, and the school nurse (if needed for medical appeals). The Committee will meet to discuss all graduation appeals by the 19<sup>th</sup> week of school.
